Raft and Resort

Activities

Horseback Ride The day after you return from the river, you will join a carefree guided **horseback trail ride**. The trail winds up Castle Creek Canyon to a perfect viewing area of Castle Valley and the renowned Castle Rock. You may recognize this area from many John Wayne western movies.

Scenic Flight By airplane you soar over the Colorado River past Island in the Sky, Dead Horse Point, and The Maze, (hideout of famous outlaws Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid.

The Weather

You can expect warm, sunny, delightful days in Southeastern Utah. In April through June, high temperatures range between 70 and 90. July and August high temperatures typically range between 90 and 100, with September and October temperatures ranging between 70 and 80. The climate here is very dry with little humidity and not oppressively sweltering. Summer evenings are quite comfortable though cool in spring and fall. Other than an occasional rain cloud, there are few overcast days.

History

A few white men settled here, and few wrote about it. There are lots of legends leaving questions about the facts. Your guides will share the stories the gold miner's cabin, the outlaw cave and the secret grave a half mile from the cave. The Old West comes alive as you walk through these sites and contemplate the legends

Geology

There are numerous secluded geological sites along the river. You will see 300 million years of rock history in a glance. Throughout time the river has sliced through this rock and left it exposed for all to see. These multi-colored layers of rock sparkle in the warm Utah sun, creating spectacular sunsets and photos.

Motion Pictures

Many production companies used Moab to shoot rafting footage for movies, documentaries and commercials. John Wayne filmed here, along with Indiana Jones, Thelma and Louise, Adventures of Joe Dirt, Independence Day and many others including several Car Commercials.

Wildlife

The canyon hosts an extraordinary diversity of plants and animals that live in many climatic environments. Wildlife is abundant in this region, though often shy. One of the West's largest herds of Desert Big Horn Sheep resides in the canyon. During the heat of the day lizards sun themselves while eagles, vultures, ravens, and hawks soar on thermal airstreams along the canyon walls. In the morning and evening, deer, muskrat, beaver, coyote and the great blue heron move along the river's edge.

Water Levels

Depending on snow pack and time of year, Colorado River water levels will vary dramatically creating diverse rafting conditions. Some rapids are more challenging at high water, while others require greater skill at low water. Different flows have their appeal, and we provide specific watercraft that will make the most of each water level.

Orientation

We hold a pre-trip orientation the evening before the trip launches. Here you will meet one of your guides, sign your release forms, receive your dry bags (river luggage), learn what to expect and how to prepare, and ask questions. The orientation is held at our office in Moab, Utah, 2231 South Highway 191 (the big blue building).
